## Does Brazil have 5G solar container communication stations

How many 5G stations are there in Brazil?

The National Telecommunications Agency (Anatel) has approved the licensing and activation of 5G technology stations in an additional 395 municipalities as of Monday, March 18. This brings the total number of municipalities with 5G coverage to 3,678, covering approximately 181.3 million Brazilians, or roughly 85 percent of the population.

How many municipalities in Brazil are eligible for 5G?

On December 2024, Anatel announced that all 5,570 municipalities in Brazil are now eligible to receive SA 5G technology, marking a significant milestone in the expansion of the next-generation network. At the time of Anatel's latest data release, it was estimated that 770 municipalities already had active 5G networks.

When will 5G be available in Brazil?

The 3.5GHz band was freed up on a rolling basis, with the process concluding on December 2, 2024, some 14 months ahead of schedule. Since that date, all 5,570 towns and cities in Brazil have been approved for 5G, although actual network deployments vary among operators.

Which country has the largest 5G subscription base?

Three-and-a-half years after receiving its 5G licenses, Vivo --Brazil's largest mobile operator by subscriptions--can claim the country's most extensive 5G subscription base. As of May 2025 (the most recent official data available), there were approximately 19.2 million users connected to its 5G Standalone network.
